Guidelines for the Exhibit:

1. Participating art educators must be current members of NYSATA Central Region #3.

3. Only **7 pieces of student artwork per art educator**. The work must be **two-dimensional and matted or low relief**, ready to hang and able to be attached to the wall with brads (small nails) or staples.
4. Securely attach a typed computer generated white label to the lower right front corner of each piece. Please include the following information for each artwork label: **Name Title Grade School District Art Educator**
