The New York State Art Teachers Association joins other state art organizations to participate in the YAM Flag Design competition. 10 winning entries will be chosen (one from each region) and used to celebrate Youth Art Month in New York. One winning entry will be replicated on the state YAM flag and flown in Washington, DC. Other winning entries will be transformed into a series of YAM posters.

Guidelines for 2011 YAM design competition:

- * Designs must be created by students of current NYSATA members.
- * Design must be submitted in a digital (scanned or photographed) format.
- * Design must include the theme: “**Art Shapes Your World**” in bold lettering.
- * Design must include the YAM logo (available on the YAM page at www.nysata.org).
- * Design must include the words: New York or NY in the design.
- * Design must be bold, 2-D, simple flat color design for reproduction.
- * **No more than one entry per teacher**
- * Designs must be digitally submitted/received no later than January 7, 2011

The ten winning entries will be displayed at the NYSATA YAM/Legislative Exhibit in March.
