To apply for a scholarship you must complete the checklist given below.

Any application which is missing any material or is incomplete in any way will not be considered.

1. Fill out the application form in full. Then, write a one page essay in which you describe yourself and your interest in art. Have a teacher who is a member of the New York State Art Teachers Association sign your application.
2. Select no more than 15 slides of your best artwork in any media. Each slide should be labeled with your name and an arrow indicating which side is up (if necessary); and numbered. Enclose a list of the slides indicating Title, Size, and Medium of each work. The slides should be contained in a clear plastic slide sheet. **If you want your slides returned, also enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your application.** Please make sure the return envelope is of appropriate size and has sufficient postage. *Note: if you are a winner of an award, NYSATA reserves the right to keep your slides and use them for display and publicity purposes.*
3. Enclose a copy of a letter of acceptance from a college or art school, and two letters of recommendation (teachers, principal, counselor, etc.).
4. Take all of your materials to your guidance counselor. They must prepare a copy of your high school transcript, check over your application materials, and submit them all in one envelope to the following address. **Please note that the application must be mailed from the guidance department of your school.**

Checklist:

- Completed application with NYSATA member teacher's signature
- Essay
- Two letters of recommendation
- Copy of letter of acceptance from college or art school
- Slides properly labeled with title and media list
- Self-addressed stamped envelope for return of slides
- High school transcript

Applications must be postmarked no later than May 15 of the year of application.
