Project Outline

Applicants should develop a project outline to be submitted with the application form. The project outline should include the following information:

- 1. An in-depth description of the project.
- 2. An explanation of how the project supports the New York State Standards for Learning in the Arts.
- 3. An explanation of why the project is innovative.
- 4. A timeline of key activities including start and end dates.
- 5. A description of how the project will contribute to your growth as an art educator as well as how it will enhance your curriculum and benefit your students, program, and school.
- 6. A detailed budget.
- 7. A proposal and date to present the project to the NYSATA membership (typically at the annual conference or as an article published in the NYSATA News).
- 8. All materials are due to the state Awards Chair by May 1.
